

A VIRTUAL TOUR OF THE ALBERT MEMORIAL

The Albert Memorial is one of the great sculptural achievements of the Victorian era. With stunning high definition images, you will be taken on a tour of the Memorial from top to bottom, revealing details of the art work that the human eye could never see on a real-life tour. The sculpture groups representing the Continents and the Industrial Arts, the statues representing the Sciences and the Virtues and, most impressive of all, the 169 figures of the Parnassus Frieze are examined close up. The complications and strife involved in the building and completion of the Memorial are discussed as well as how it embodies the ideals and aspirations of the Victorian Age.
